

Glens HOA Fallen Tree Policy

Guidelines put forth by the Glens at Country Creek Homeowners Association in regards to fallen trees or limbs.

1. The removal of fallen trees or limbs on homeowner's property is the responsibility of the homeowner.
2. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to have the trees or limbs removed by a licensed and insured vendor as soon as possible, especially if the fallen tree or limb is obstructing the right of way.
 - a. The Glens Homeowners Association will be responsible for the expense of removal of the percentage of the tree which falls on the common areas as determined by the vendor at the time of service. Any reimbursements owed to a homeowner will be processed promptly after receipt of the bill by the management company.
 - b. Please contact a board member whenever possible to help you determine the Glens Homeowners Association's responsibility. If this is not possible, please photograph the fallen tree(s) or limb(s). Digital photos are acceptable.
3. No tree(s) or large limb(s) should ever be moved to the common areas for storage. The tree(s) or limb(s) should remain on your property until removal is complete. Severe storm or hurricane debris is the exception respectively.
